

BIOGRAPHY



Professor Zbigniew Kowalewski graduated from Faculty of Mechanics, Warsaw University of Technology (1981). The Ph.D. and habilitation he received at the Institute of Fundamental Technological Research of the Polish Academy of Sciences in 1988 and 1997, respectively. In 2008 Professor Zbigniew Kowalewski was nominated by president of Poland as full Professor in Mechanical Engineering.

He was the British Council Fellow from 1992 to 1993 at the University of Manchester.

Professor Zbigniew Kowalewski was appointed at the Institute of Fundamental Technological Research of the Polish Academy of Sciences since 1985, and also at the Warsaw University of Technology from 1997 to 2010. Since 2011 he is a Head of the Department for Strength of Materials at Institute of Fundamental Technological Research of the Polish Academy of Sciences. His 30 years research work experience is mainly devoted to: plasticity, creep, fatigue, experimental methods in solid mechanics, modelling of creep constitutive equations. He is an author or co-author of more than 320 papers published in well known international journals and conference proceedings, 14 books, and 6 patents.
